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Midland County Damage Assessment Report Submitted to the State

The results of the flooding event that began on May 18th have been catastrophic for Midland County residents, businesses and non-profit agencies.

Preliminary Damage assessments have been submitted for nearly 2500 homes, businesses and nonprofits with estimated losses of almost \$175 million.

Of those 2500 properties; 115 are considered destroyed, 790 have major damage and the rest with minor damage and impacted levels of damage. Current information shows only 8% of these damages were insured.

Public property (local government agencies) and emergency response costs for governmental agencies have estimated damages at over \$34 million.

All damage assessments have been submitted to the State of Michigan to the Governor's Office in hopes of a request for a major disaster declaration by the President.

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
