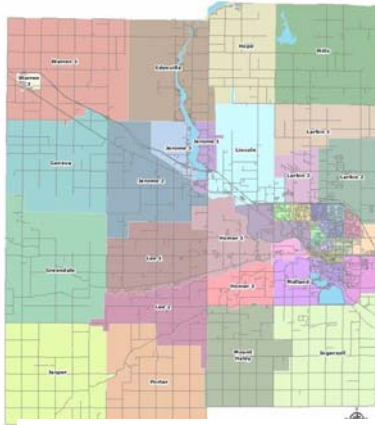




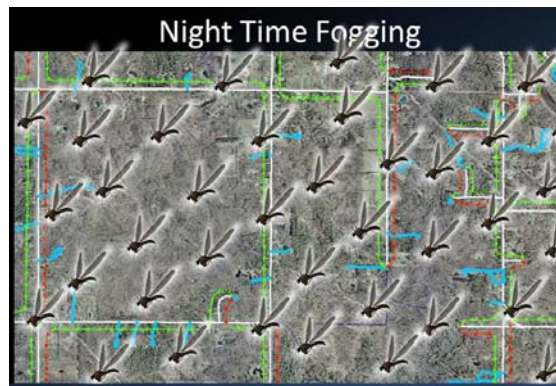
Summer Mosquito Fogging

Midland County Mosquito Control (MCMC) focuses on area-wide mosquito reduction to decrease disease risk and improve quality of life. Several fogging routes are established among county townships.

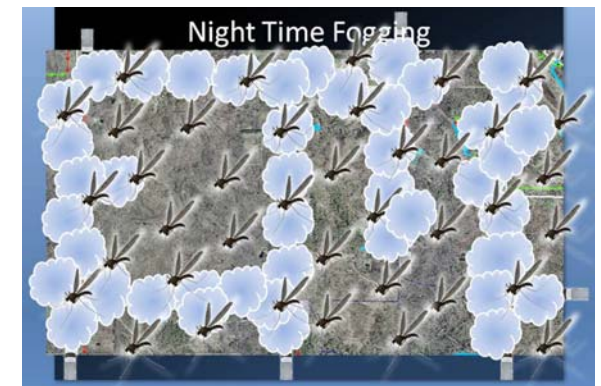


Several fogging routes exist for control of adult mosquitoes

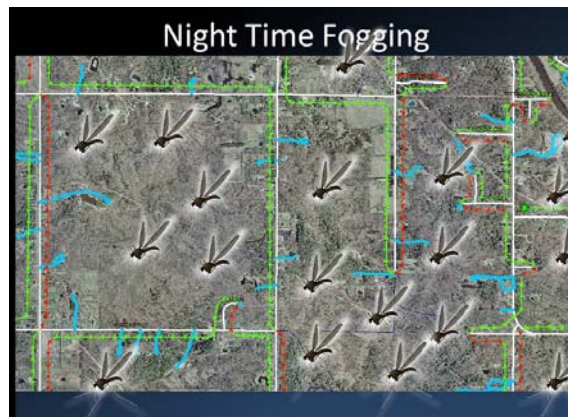
MCMC treats the adult flying mosquitoes with Ultra Low Volume (ULV) technology that dispenses very small amounts of material (1 oz. per acre). The machines break the material down into tiny droplets which remain suspended in the air for a matter of minutes and are then quickly broken down. The fog impinges on flying adult mosquitoes thereby reducing the population. ULV fog does NOT treat standing water or provide residual effect on surfaces such as foliage.



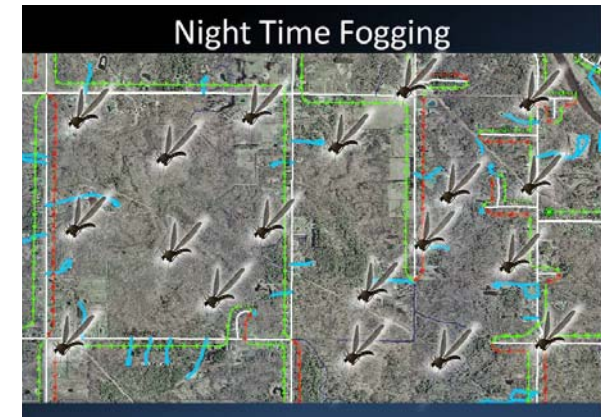
A. Mosquitoes occur throughout a region



B. Fogging controls mosquitoes that directly contact material while those outside of fog are unaffected



C. Mosquitoes in the area are reduced following fogging



D. Those that remain move into areas previously fogged. Repeated fogging will further reduce overall mosquito populations
