



PARK CONCEPT

History Trails link all sites of interest. Benches and interpretive signs are provided at each site.

Nature Excellent opportunities to experience wildlife: 3 fishing platforms, 2 wildlife viewing towers, 1 kayak portaging area, over 2 miles of primary & secondary trails, and over 2,000 feet of boardwalk through wetland areas. One fishing platform is linked by a short barrier free trail to the main parking lot.

Family The main picnic area has two covered pavilions and restrooms are nearby at the trailhead.

Ritual Two wedding ceremony sites are available. One is a short walk away from the main parking area, and the other overlooks the convergence of the Tobacco and Tittabawassee Rivers.

Access The main parking lot is set-back and buffered from residential areas and sits on a flat, open area. It can hold up to 35 autos. A smaller parking lot is located to the north and can hold up to 10 vehicles.
