

IN COMPLIANCE WITH ACT NUMBER 87 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1985

If you have been the victim of **any crime**, you are entitled to the following information:

1. If you have been injured in any way, you may obtain medical treatment from:
 - a) Your personal or family physician
 - b) Urgent Care-Midland, 3009 North Saginaw Road 633-1350
 - c) MidMichigan Medical Center-Midland, 4005 Orchard Drive 839-3100
 - d) Redi-Med, Inc., 4715 Eastman Road, Midland 631-7110
2. For more information on your rights as the victim of a crime, you may contact the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney, 220 W. Ellsworth Street, Midland at 989-832-6722. Office hours are 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday and their website is www.co.midland.mi.us.
3. You may be eligible for victim compensation by calling the Victim Rights Coordinator at the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney at 989-832-6732. You may also inquire with the Victim Compensation Board at Post Office Box 30026, Lansing, MI 48909. Their phone number is 1-517-373-7373; however, please begin with the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney.
4. Anytime you are not notified of an arrest in your case, you may call the law enforcement agency that is handling your complaint:

5. If an arrest has been made in your case, you may contact the Midland County Jail to determine whether the defendant has been released from custody. There is a possibility that this suspect can be released from custody prior to the time and date of pretrial by posting a bond.

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6. A victim of crime may be informed of inmate status and upcoming court hearings by registering with the Michigan Crime Victim Notification Network. Registration can be completed online at www.vinelink.com, by telephone at 1-800-770-7657, or by contacting the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney at 989-832-6732.

INFORMATION FOR VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Pursuant to 1985 PA 222, Peace Officers, after intervening in a domestic dispute as described in MCL 764.15a or 764.1b, are required to give the victim the following notice:

- All reports of domestic violence or violations of personal protection orders will be submitted to the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney for review.
- You also have the right to go to court and file a petition requesting an injunction order from domestic abuse which could include the following:
 - a) An order restraining or enjoining the abuser from entering onto the premises
 - b) An order restraining or enjoining the abuser from assaulting, beating, molesting, or wounding you.
 - c) An order restraining or enjoining the abuser from removing minor children from you, except as otherwise authorized by a custody or visitation order issued by a court of competent jurisdiction.
 - d) An order restraining or enjoining the abuser from threatening to kill or physically injure you.
